## Support for the Arts in the Valley Grows for the Third Year Running!

The heART of the Valley Art Show & Sale is coming to a close for a third year at the Macdonald Museum in Middleton, but you still have time to check it out. This year's heART Show theme is Water is Life and showcases an astounding 127 pieces of art created by more than 100 local artists, artisans, hobbyists and youth of all ages, skill levels, from 6 different counties, all in one room!

At the heART show, you are the judge! Help us determine who wins the top prizes in each of 4 categories: Professional Artists & Artisans; Community Hobbyists; Emerging Artists (13-18); and Future Artists (12 & under). This People's Choice show depends on your vote to help choose the winners of each category. Every visit gets you a new ballot and a new chance to help your favourite talent get closer to the win!

The Artists Reception will be held on Saturday, July 11 from 2-4pm where the winners will be announced and prizes are awarded. We look forward to welcoming artists, family, friends, and art lovers at the reception - it is a great opportunity to mix and mingle, meet some artists, and enjoy some light refreshments. Voting closes promptly at 2:30pm on July 11 during the Reception. While the final ballots are counted, and artists anxiously await the announcements, guests can enjoy instrumental acoustic music provided by local musician Lorne Allan or explore The Mac - this year there is a Pirate exhibit complete with a Treasure Hunt to keep those youngsters entertained. New this year, we added "heART notes", as a way to express your appreciation to the artists for those pieces you really love, even if you can't take them all home!

The show and sale continues during regular museum hours until July 18 when the Mac hosts its annual Summer Craft Market. Whether you pop in for a quick peek, are looking for a special gift, or a little something for yourself, there are well over 100 art works available for sale. Art prices start at \$20 with many pieces of original local art for under \$100, but with stunning fine art so there is truly something for everyone.

Artists keep 75% of the sales so every purchase supports local artists in our community. This year, with cuts to funding in the arts and at museums, your support means more than ever!

The Water is Life show is a real treat welcoming plenty of new artists, and numerous returning artists, with many that have participated in all 3 shows! We have really wonderful pieces from Future Artists as young as 7 years old and have an impressive selection of art from local teen Emerging Artists. There is an assortment of work from incredible Community Hobbyists in a variety of mediums, many who are bravely exhibiting for the first time. We are thrilled to house 45 works from skilled Professional Artists & Artisans. The combined talent in this one space is something not to miss. Give yourself time for your visit because there is so much wonderful art to take in.
