The Chimney Swifts are back!

Have you seen them? Heard them? They may be easier to hear than to see. Listen for their "chittering" sound, not musical, but quite distinctive.

Their numbers are increasing as they arrive from their wintering grounds in Peru, 6000km away. Last Sunday over 125 were counted entering the Bridgetown Roost Tower, the big chimney in the Memorial Park by the Sports Hub, on Faye Road.

By sunset time (sunrise-sunset.org/ca/Bridgetown) the swifts are usually gathering overhead above the roost; if it is a cool evening, they will likely enter the roost earlier, but on a warm evening they will linger, sometimes until it is almost too dark to see them. Watching them enter the roost is memorable but does require patience. Plan to arrive a bit before sunset.

Another visitor to watch for is the merlin, a small falcon, which nests somewhere around the Bridgetown area. This year it has been seen and heard from the swimming pool to the Sports hub. We mention it here because merlins prey on chimney swifts.

No connection, but there is a valuable tool for identifying birds, especially by sound, called the Merlin bird app. It is free and comes from the Cornell Lab of Ornithology. Download it and start exploring what you are seeing and hearing in the bird world. It's also a great way to introduce kids to the world of birds. Happy birding!

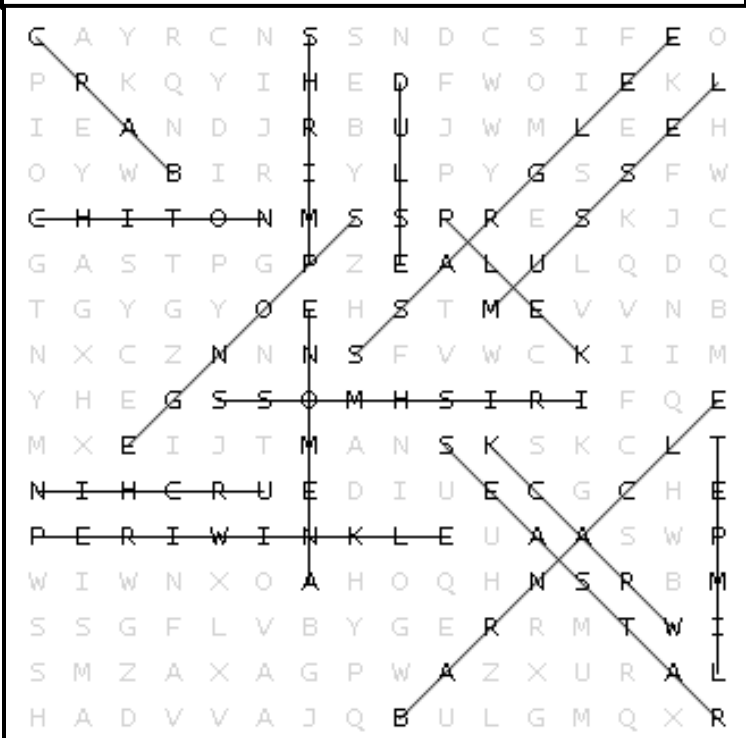

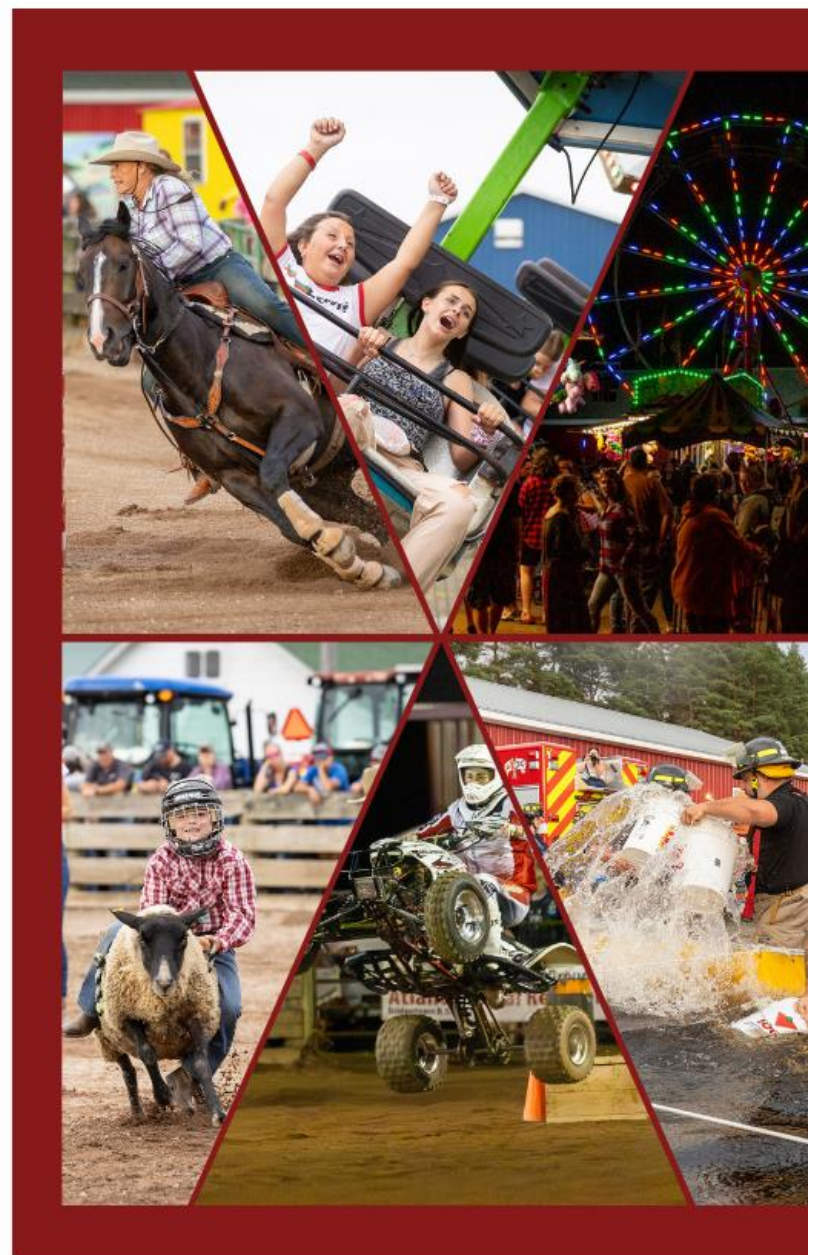
