Askance Publishing of Annapolis Royal, NS is delighted to announce that Allison Maher, best-selling Nova Scotian author of two previous YA novels, has signed with Askance to publish her debut adult novel The Last Of The Firsts. Publication is expected in October 2024.

Allison has retired from farming in the Annapolis Valley and says that she now spends her time writing, cleaning shorelines, irritating politicians, and entertaining dogs.

The Last Of The Firsts charts the year in the life of fourteen-year-old Thor and his aunt following the death of Thor's mother, and is told from Thor's point of view. Slowly they both move from the intense anguish of their loss through grieving and readjustment towards their goal of The Last Of The Firsts: through Thor's first birthday without his mother, the first Christmas, the first hockey game, the first Thanksgiving, the first time for everything. Told with great insight, understanding and humour, their journey together will resonate with readers of every age.

## New Sign Base at Sports Hub

The electronic sign in Memorial Park has a new brick base. Ted Gillis is the craftsman/artist who was challenged to create the base. When he heard that the structure was to be dedicated to Bill Hirtle's extraordinary contribution to school and community he immediately said yes to the challenge. His unique and original design is a thoughtful, heartfelt and creative representation of Bridgetown Regional High School. Both ends of the base have rounded curves to exemplify the rounded sides of the old building and are made of bricks from the old school. The sides have an intricate pattern of protruding bricks which, once again, are old school brick. The plaque dedicated to Mr. Hirtle's commitment to his community is seated on a base made entirely from school brick.

Take a few minutes to stop by and look at the features and craftsmanship that make the base one-of-kind and a fitting tribute.

## Two Planks to Stage "The Mountain And The Valley"

Two Planks and a Passion is an award-winning professional theatre company in residence at the Ross Creek Centre for the Arts, offering exquisite outdoor productions in a spectacular setting.

This summer our mainstage is The Mountain and the Valley, a collaboration with HomeFirst Theatre and Two Planks and Passion Theatre. Adapted from the beloved novel by Ernest Buckler and set in this very region, The Mountain and the Valley examines how community makes a person who they are, and is both familiar and universal, beautiful, funny, and poignant. The Mountain and the Valley, by Governor General's Award-winning playwright Catherine Banks, adapted from the beloved novel by Ernest Buckler, is directed by Guillermo Verdecchia and a spoken word chorus directed by musical director Allen Cole.

It is the Annapolis Valley between the Great Wars and David Canaan, beloved grandson, son, brother, and twin to Anna is on the cusp of manhood. Brilliant, sensitive, observant and the pride of his community his future shines with promise. And yet at 33 he stands alone at the top of the South Mountain looking back at the miscommunications and the misunderstandings that have derailed his dreams. The Mountain and the Valley asks how is it that such promise has not come to pass and can we ever begin again?

Ernest Buckler, (born West Dalhousie, NS, July 19, 1908; died at Bridgetown, NS, March 4, 1984), was one of Canada's most respected authors. He studied at Dalhousie and University of Toronto, then worked for 5 years as an actuarial mathematician in Toronto before ill health led to his return to the Annapolis Valley.

He began writing short stories, but The Mountain and the Valley (1952) brought him wide-spread recognition. Other books include The Cruellest Month (1963); Ox Bells and Fireflies (1968), a "fictional memoir"; Nova Scotia: Window on the Sea (1973); and The Rebellion of Young David and Other Stories (1975). Whirligig (1977), a volume of light verse and prose, won the Leacock Award for Humour (1978).

The Mountain and the Valley runs through the summer beginning Wednesday June 26. Tickets are \$34 for adults, \$25 for students/artist/forces/unwaged, \$10 for kids.
